



Canine Commons at The Meadows Rules & Regulations

- Canine Commons at The Meadows Community Association (MCA) is open solely to residents of The Meadows who have registered their pets and submitted proof of pet's vaccination to the MCA in advance of entry.
- Renaissance Access Card required while utilizing the park.
- The dog park is open from dawn to dusk.
- **USE of dog park IS AT YOUR OWN RISK. RESIDENTS are SOLEY RESPONSIBLE for their OWN SAFETY and for their DOGS.**
- **Residents assume all liability for damages to any person, dog or the facility caused by the resident or their dog.**
- **The MCA is not responsible for any injury or damage.**
- All dogs must be properly licensed, must be healthy and have proof of current vaccinations.
- All dogs must wear a collar and ID tag with owner's name, phone number.
- All dogs must be accompanied by their owner.
- Children under the age of 13 must be supervised by an adult.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are prohibited in the park.
- Aggressive or non-socialized dogs are prohibited in the park.
- Dog waste must be picked up and disposed of in the receptacles provided.
- Operating equipment capable of extending beyond a height of 14 feet above existing grade is NOT Allowed under FPL Power Easement.
- **Portable shade structures are PROHIBITED.**
- Dog owners who fail to comply with the above rules may be asked to leave the park and may have their Canine Commons entry revoked.
- **Notify Meadows Safety Patrol at 941-809-0084 to report any incidents in the park. In the event of an emergency, call 911 first.**
