



GOLF CART REGISTRATION GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

Registering your golf cart with The Meadows identifies that you are a resident of the community and you have the right to operate and park in The Meadows. It provides our safety patrol a way of identifying those that do not belong in our community. Florida law states that golf carts can be operated on private roads, subject to the Association's rules and regulations for their use.

GOLF CART RULES & BASIC SAFETY PROCEDURES

- Golf carts may be operated on the private roads and pathways of MCA.
**TMCC rules govern use of any carts on their leased golf cart paths.*
- Minimum age requirement for operating a golf cart is 16 and all drivers shall hold a driver's license.
- Carts must be registered with MCA and the owner provide copy of umbrella insurance page covering them.
- Carts operated between dusk and dawn must have headlights and taillights.
- All golf carts using the bike paths must be equipped with a warning device such as a horn or a bell to alert other users of the paths.
- Cart operators are required to drive in a safe manner and yield to automobiles when on roadways.
- Bicycles and pedestrians have the right of way over golf carts on those paths available to all three types.
- All vehicles shall be operated with due regard for the safety of others.
- All golf carts are required to abide by the posted speed limits within The Meadows.
- Owners and operators of all types of carts shall comply with Meadows rules.
- Do not obstruct or interfere with normal traffic flow.
- Do not stand or extend body parts outside the perimeter of the golf cart while the golf cart is being operated.
- The golf cart must be kept in good operational order.
