DIVISIONS: Men's Doubles & Ladies Doubles [3.0], [3.5], [4.0] & [Open] Divisions

FORMAT: Division formatting & start times will depend on the number of teams entered. Teams should expect to play at least 2 matches and must be available to play ALL days. Wed--Fri are preliminary rounds, formatting will depend on the number of teams entered. Saturday morning is typically the Semi-Finals and/or Finals Matches. Players are responsible for checking tournament schedule for start times.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Saturday, April 4th @ 1PM.

COST: \$15.00 ENTRY PER PLAYER (Goes toward awards, tournament balls and beverages)
(Pay-Per-Play players' regular court fees would apply for event matches)

ENTRY RULES: Open to all Registered Players (All Pass Holders & Pay-Per-Plays)

USTA Rules govern play.
The "Meadows 15-Minute Default Rule" in effect.
Koman Rotation for all tiebreaks.
Where available, players must first use their USTA rating.
If USTA rating is unavailable, players are to use their local league rating.
If neither is available, the tournament director will issue a rating.
Players are welcome to play up in divisions.
